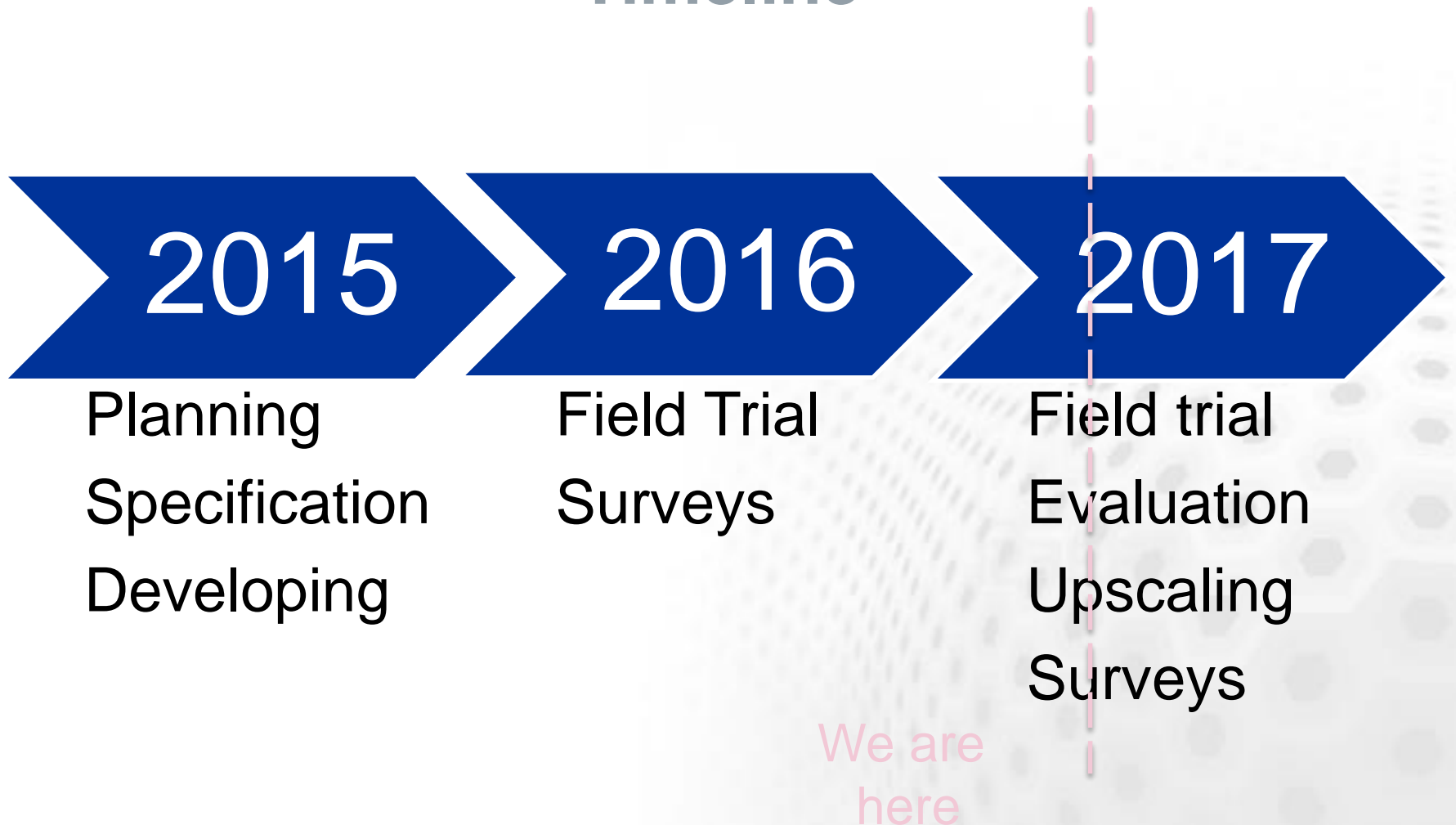

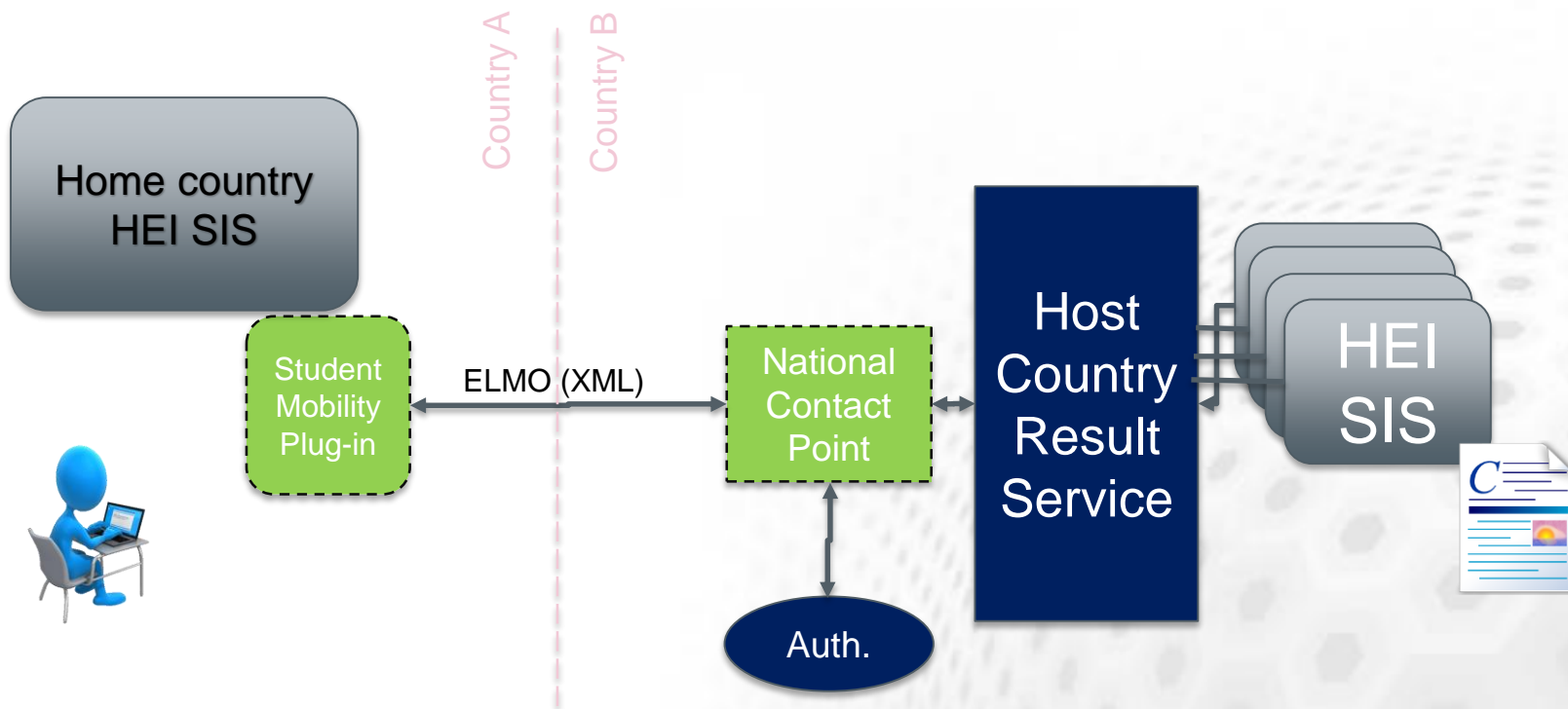

Field trial results so far

- Finland, Italy, Norway, Sweden in production
- Danish NCP in production soon
- Not that much exchange between Nordic countries, e.g. in Finland 50-70 students contacted
- Usage so far:

Country	HEIs	Students
Denmark	0	0
Finland	9	40
Italy	1	(5)
Norway	9	66
Sweden	6(19)	10(66)

EMREX+

- Applied for extension of project 2018 ->
- Key scope:
 - Expand to new EU countries and more HEIs in the existing
 - Deepen integration into the recognition process.
 - Prototype innovative ways of using EMREX, including admission services and credential evaluation.
 - Synergies with Erasmus App, EWP, EGRACONS,OLA, eIDAS.
 - Develop the ELMO standard; admission, diploma supplements, 2nd level education.
 - Open to cooperation with non-EU countries.

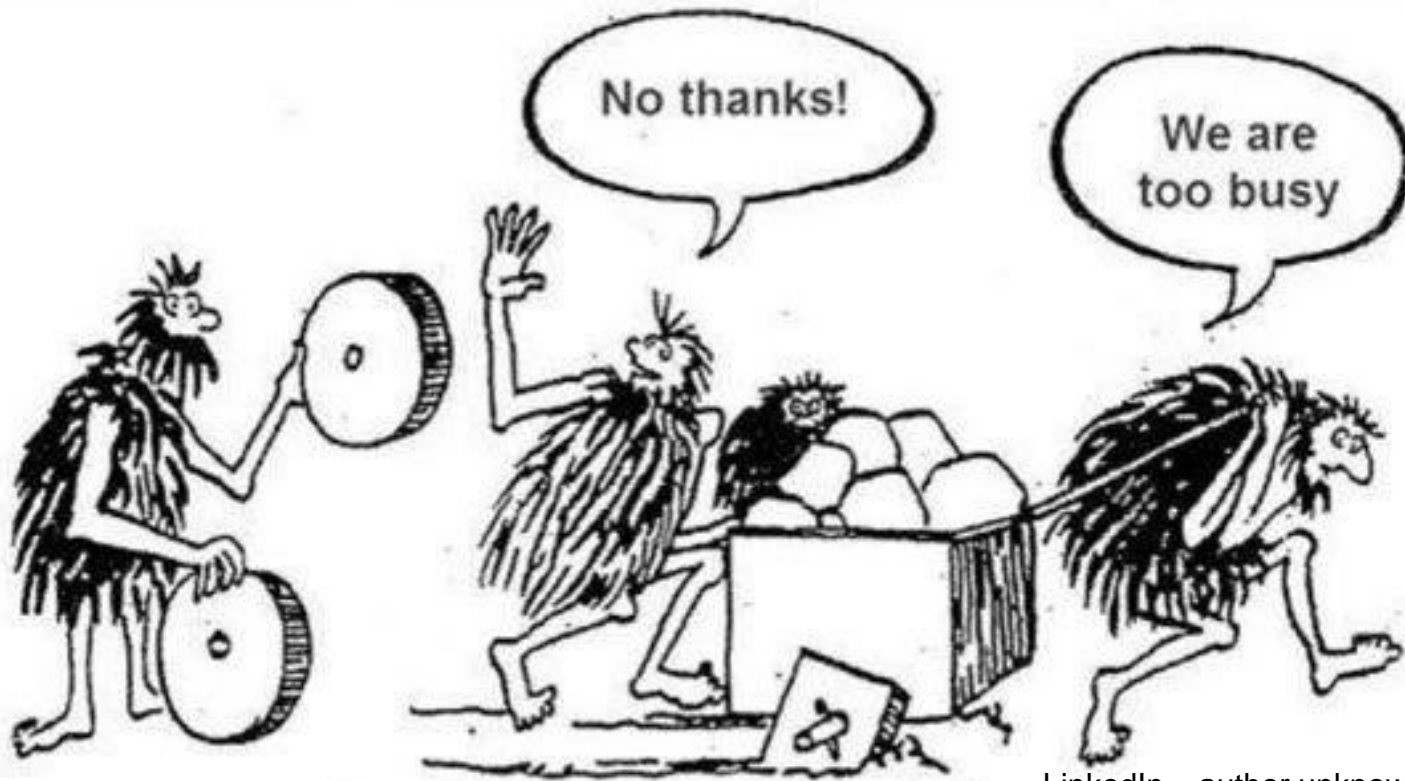
