# Learning Agreement a key Erasmus+ document

- 1. Signed x3, guarantees ECTS recognition
- 2. Before and during mobility (and possibly after)
- 1. Mandatory and unavoidable





# Learning Agreement a key Erasmus+ document but....

- 1. 25% of LAs are not signed before departure
- 2. 71% of students make changes to LA while abroad
- 1. Such changes are major risk factor for nonrecognition of courses upon return





# Learning Agreement perceived workload

- 90% of IROs consider E+ administrative workload "high or very high"
- LA considered the most important step/document to be digitised



## OLA goals and envisaged impact




- Improve quality of mobility experience (students)
- 2. Improve the nature of the work carried out by IROs (HEIs)
- Decrease cost of that work (HEIs/gov)

### OLA impact / results

- 1000+ students tested(ing) the beta tool
  - evaluation to be carried out this Spring
  - first signs are very encouraging
- •150+ HEIs subscribed the platform
  - interesting community of mobility experts





## OLA findings IRO perspective

- Had not anticipated such strong demand for a university backend
- Beta launched at EAIE
  - upload of nominations
  - overall management of LAs
